Decisions, Decisions, Decisions

All our lives we make decisions. When we make decisions, we also need to weigh up the consequences of our actions – and sometimes that is not always easy. We are all responsible for the decisions we make, irrespective of how we make them.

Even Jesus had decisions to make.

Sometimes we forget that Jesus had to choose to obey God, and this wasn't always easy for him at all. There were points in his life when he had to decide to continue following the path to the cross.

Now, it is very easy to think that Jesus as the Son of God, was immune from emotions. But he wasn't. He battles with what we all know so well, which is the powerful human instinct to preserve ourselves and avoid pain and conflict.

Being the Son of God did not immunize Jesus against the struggle of sacrifice. He felt the pain of this decision-making acutely.

Remember that Jesus was fully human and fully God, and so He experienced all the emotions, all the temptations, the difficulties we face. He also had to make his own decisions about following his Fathers will.

The same applies to us. We need to make the decision to follow Jesus, then after that, we must work out how to live our life of faith in amongst the busyness and challenges of the world.

Then as life crowds in on us, we may have to revisit our commitment to Jesus again, and to reflect and then recommit ourselves to him and his mission in the world. It might well be that over a lifetime we may need to do this several times.

It is a good thing to reflect on our life and faith with Jesus, and to make any adjustments that are necessary for us to keep our focus on him.

And if Jesus, himself, needed to renew his commitment to His Heavenly Father at various points in his life - then how much more will we have to do this too.
