Who is Calling?

The heart of Christianity is about being in a relationship with God through Jesus Christ, and this relationship has often been described in the Bible through the imagery of sheep and shepherds.

Back then the sheep were dependent upon their Shepherd for their daily needs, and the Shepherd would look after them all their lives.

So, when Jesus described himself as the good shepherd, he was using imagery that the people of his day were very familiar with.

Jesus, the Good Shepherd knows his sheep, his people, and he calls them by name to follow him.

But how do we actually recognize the voice of our Shepherd in the midst of all the other voices that speak around us?

The only way to do this is by being in a relationship with him, just like those sheep out in the fields being in a relationship with their shepherd. The more time we spend with God and His Word, the easier it is to recognize His voice and His leading in our lives.

Jesus wants to lead us to abundant, everlasting life, and like sheep, we must recognise his voice, lift our heads and follow after him.

The Lord is indeed our shepherd, he leads us to green pastures and still waters so that our souls may be restored.

He is indeed the Shepherd and the Guardian of our souls.
