# OPERATION COVER UP

## Knitted Blanket

### Preferred Blanket Size:

At least 160cm x 140cm

Use: size 8 (4mm) needles

DK (8py yarn)

Cast on: 40 stitches and knit in garter  
stitch (every row knit)

Knit for 80 rows (40 ridges)

Cast off – each square measures approx  
20cm x 20cm

56 squares sewn together make blanket  
(8 squares H x 7 squares W)

or

knit 7 strips consisting of 8 squares – and  
sew the 7 strips together to form a blanket  
160cm x 140cm
