



Who are the seven giants in the Bible?

When the Lord your God brings you into the land where you are entering to take possession of it, and he drives away many nations from before you, the Hittites, the Girgashites, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites, seven nations greater and mightier than you, and when the Lord your God turns them over to you and you defeat them, you shall utterly destroy them. You shall not make a covenant with them nor be gracious to them. **Deuteronomy 7:1-3**

Giants in the Land

The story of David facing the Philistine giant, is one of the dramatic stories in the Bible. It involves high stakes as there is no middle ground. It's about life and death; win or lose.

David trusted God and did what he knew. But before David confronted Goliath, he prepared himself for the battle.

He took off the things that were weighing him down. In his case, Saul's armour, which was way too big and heavy for him to wear.

Then he gathered 5 smooth stones from the stream, put them in his shepherd's bag, and with his sling in his hand he approached the giant.

Those 5 stones could be seen to be a representation of the experience and power of God operating behind the scenes through:

The Spirit of God

The experience of God's power

The Word of God

The vision of God for the future

Faith in God

Like David we need to listen to God, use the tools that God has given us and to stand on the solid rock of our faith.

This doesn't mean that we won't feel anxious when we face our problems, but it does mean that we will have the resources we need, in God, to face life's challenges.

And as we stand in the shadow of giant, may we remember that God has promised to be always with us.

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13
