There is still some pottles of Donald's honey in the office. \$8 for 500g tub.

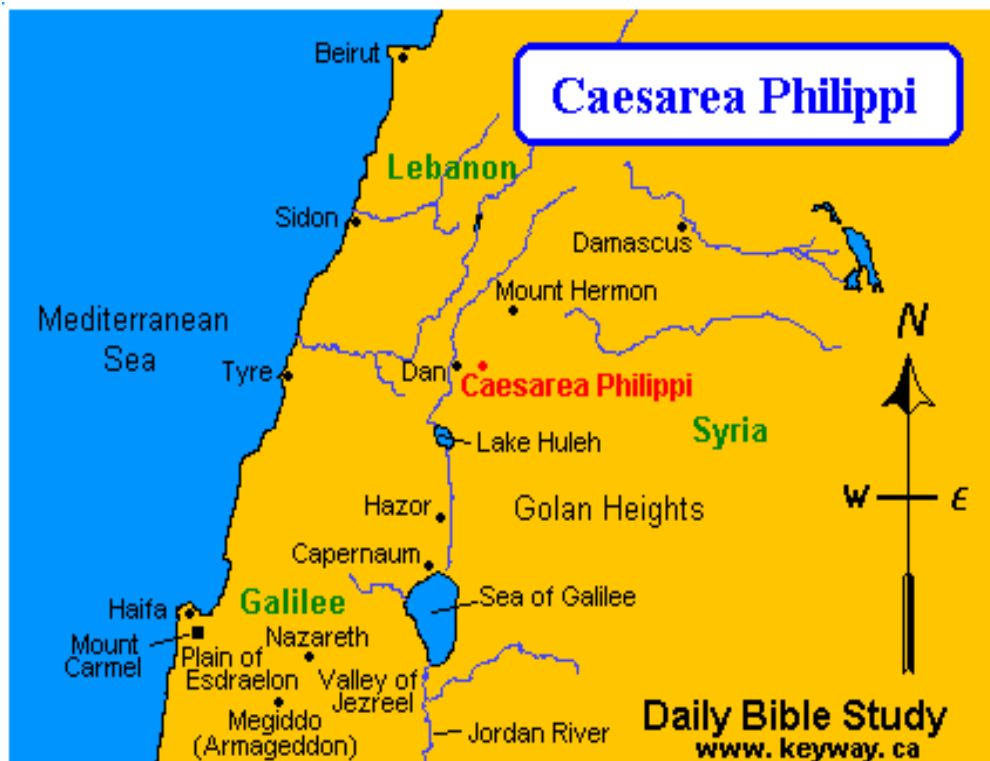
