Our Worship Today

Pentecost is often called "the birthday of the Church" because with the coming of the Holy Spirit, power was given to the church to move and grow. In our services today may the Holy Spirit of God blow upon us afresh. As the words of Hymn 320: "Breathe on me, breath of God, fill me with life anew that I may love what thou dost love, and do what Thou wouldst do".

The name "Pentecost" means "The Fiftieth" and was so called because it fell on the fiftieth day after the Passover. The feast of Pentecost had two main significances:

1. It commemorated the giving of the law to Moses on Mount Sinai.
2. It was a Harvest Thanksgiving Festival.

It was a public holiday and because of the better weather at that time of year, (June) more people came to Pentecost than to Passover. That explains the roll of countries mention in Acts 2.

Now we must not think that the Holy Spirit came into existence at Pentecost. God is eternally Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Acts make that quite clear, For example, the Holy Spirit was speaking to David (Acts 2:16).

Yet Pentecost is important, for the Holy Spirit came to the Christian church in a very special way. The early church was a Spirit-filled church, and there lay its power.

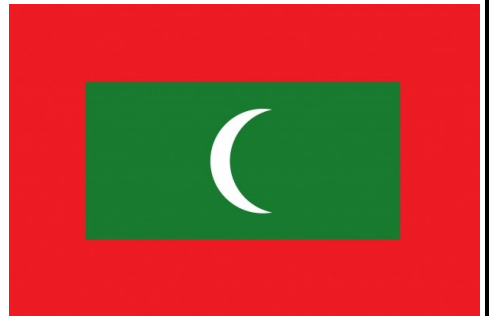
